

Minutes for the extra Meeting held at The Playing Field Pavilion, Harome on Wednesday 19 August 2015 at 7:30pm

Present; Cllrs Preston (Chairman), Pickard, Rooke and Wardle

1. There were no apologies for absence
2. There were no Declarations of Interest in items on the agenda
3. No members of the public were present
4. Planning – To consider planning applications received from RDC and NYCC since the previous meeting
 - a) [15/00857/FUL](#) Formation of vehicular access with hardcore turning area | Land West Of River Riccal Helmsley

The Council expressed concern regarding the need for hardcore standing in a grass paddock of this size. The Council also noted that the smaller of the two submitted plans already indicate a property in situ which is not the case.

Historically the field has, for the last year been used for childrens' motorised grass track activity and the storage of waste building materials. The application plan also indicates that no "change of use" within proposal para 3 but Clerk had previously RDC regarding the movement of rubble.

The Council noted that the site area of 1432m² but no indication of the actual area of hardcore being applied for

The form dated 24 July 2015 A4 sheets "Application for Planning" still indicates "land EAST of Rye House Farm" in contrast to the heading of the application registered

The Council objects to the planning application as this appears to be a start of development of the land for other purposes given the recent failed applications and the inconsistencies in the completion of both the A4 application and the maps provided

5. Play Area
 - a) The Clerk presented the draft Play Area check list for weekly checks. The form was accepted and Cllr Pickard to do the play checks to the next meeting.
 - b) The Clerk reported areas of concern in respect of play area checks completed since the last meeting including damage to one of the tyre swings (now repaired) and degeneration to the steps accessing the slide.

Council noted that the annual inspection is due to take place in the near future and issues raised will be addressed prior to this

6. The Chairman informed the Council that she had received a query regarding the replacement street lantern in Main Street – the Clerk advised the Council that she had contacted NYCC and received an update regarding the works order which in its first instance has been raised, a further works order will then be raised subsequent to the replacement lantern being installed to connect the service.

Parking issues on the Church corner and pavement parking generally – the Clerk to contact NYCC for advice

Speeding through the Village was raised by Cllr Pickard was also raised.

Cllrs noted concerns regarding the positioning of the 30 mph signs and the Clerk was asked to investigate the possibility of sign movement with NYCC
