1. There were no Apologies for absence
2. There were no Declarations of Interest in items on the agenda
3. Minutes and Matters arising:
 - a) The minutes of the Meeting held on 4 July 2016 were approved
 - b) There were no matters arising from the meetings held on 4 July 2016 not covered elsewhere on the agenda

6. To consider financial matters
 - a) The Council received financial statements in respect of funds held and money movement since the start of the financial year
 - b) The Council agreed the payment of cheques according to the list provided
7. Street Lighting
 - a) The Council received the revised street lamp plans for the village.
 - b) The Council considered replacing Mill Street LP1 following the survey of lights noting the current light is not suitable for repair. The cost for the is £702 plus VAT

The Council requested a breakdown of the cost but acknowledged that a replacement light would be necessary

- c) The Council noted that NYCC have been advised that Main Street LP3 is currently not working. The lamp type is currently an MBFU and could possibly be obsolete.
- d) The Council considered pre authorising the Clerk to acknowledge repair or replacement costs to the value of £850 ex VAT should Main Street LP3 require major repair/replacement.

The Council preauthorised the Clerk to instruction to replace the light to the value of £702 ex VAT

8 Play Area

- a) Cllr Rooke has reviewed the state of the equipment. Cllr Preston reported that a wasp's nest has been removed.
- b) To consider action to be taken as a result of the play area checks acknowledging verbal reports from third party suppliers.

The Council suggested that where possible patching would take place until full reports are received

- c) The Council received further quotes for update to the Play Area.

The Council instructed the Clerk to actively seek grant funding to the value of the largest quotation for updating the play area
